- Manage cash flow and act as a counter signatory for cheques, bank payments and important applications to funders.

The ideal Treasurer will have an interest in CPRE Hampshire's objectives and enthusiasm for the challenges that a small charity experiences. They will bring experience of serving on boards and the gravitas and financial background needed to effectively carry out the role. They will be at ease working closely with our Chair and Operations Manager.

We are looking for someone with strategic insight, someone who is not afraid to question but who will build positive relationships with other Trustees, volunteers and the office team. A strong financial, business or legal background is advantageous and an accountancy qualification desirable.
